- 1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Award B-04-26 LIVINGSTON ROAD LANDSCAPE & IRRIGATION (FROM BONITA BEACH ROAD TO COLLIER COUNTY LINE) to the sole bidder meeting all requirements, Vila & Son Landscaping Corporation for a total base bid not-to-exceed amount of \$284,340.80. Also approve Alternate B, Irrigation Installation for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$12,760.00. Also approve Budget Transfer of \$91,143.00 from the Bonita Beach Road Widening project to the Livingston/Imperial Connection Project and amend FY 04/05-08/09 CIP. This project was anticipated and funds will be available upon execution of the Budget Transfer.
- **2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES:** Provides the County with a Contractor for the installation of plant material, underground irrigation system, well, pump, electrical, signage, directional boring, and landscape and irrigation maintenance on Livingston Road from Bonita Beach Road to the Collier County line.

9. Background:

The Department of Transportation submitted a request to the Contracts Management office to obtain bids for the Livingston Road Landscape & Irrigation project. The expected cost of the project required the use of the formal advertised sealed bid procedure.

On the bidding deadline of July 14, 2004, Contracts Management received only one (1) bid.

Project Statistics: Contracts Management office mailed 51 notices to contractors. Nine (9) Contractors picked up the Bidding Documents with seven (7) Contractors in attendance at the pre-bid meeting. The DOT Operations staff was able to make contact with the majority of the document holders regarding their decision not to submit a bid. The major reason cited was that the sign and electrical aspects of the project were beyond their normal scope of work.

The Department of Transportation has reviewed the sole bid submitted by Vila & Son Landscaping Corporation and additionally, compared the bid with the Consultant's (WilsonMiller) project estimate. They have deemed that it is a reasonable bid within industry standards and are recommending award of B-04-26 LIVINGSTON ROAD LANDSCAPE & IRRIGATION (FROM BONITA BEACH ROAD TO COLLIER COUNTY LINE) to the sole bidder, Vila & Son Landscaping Corporation for a total base bid not-to-exceed amount of \$284,340.80. Also approve Alternate B, Irrigation Installation for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$12,760.00.

After reviewing the sole bid for the Livingston Road L&I Project, I have found the total amount shown for the Vila & Son bid to be commensurate with our OPC. Please note, however, that there are certain irrigation items that exceed the industry average, as stated in our irrigation sub-consultant's review. Also consider many plant material items were well below the industry average. As the two discrepancies seem to balance resulting in an amount that does not exceed our OPC, I have no reservations recommending award of this bid to Vila & Son.
