**RESOLUTION**

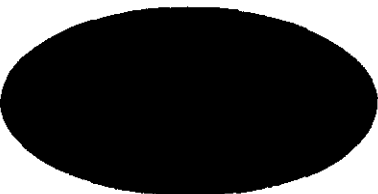
- Whereas: Unintentional childhood injury remains the number one killer of children ages 14 and under; and
- Whereas: Each year, more than 92,000 children ages 14 and under are permanently disabled as a result of unintentional injuries and more than 14 million children sustain an injury serious enough to require medical attention; and
- Whereas: Lee County Safe Kids Coalition, a member of the National SAFE KIDS Campaign network, led by Lee County Health Department unites public, private, and voluntary organizations to reduce preventable childhood injuries in Lee County through community awareness activities, educational programs, and public policy advocacy; and
- Whereas: the National SAFE KIDS Campaign promotes childhood injury prevention by uniting diverse groups into local and state coalitions, developing innovative educational tools and strategies, initiating public policy changes, promoting new technology, and raising awareness about a range of risk areas; and providing safety education through health and safety events; and
- Whereas: Lee County Safe Kids Coalition, in partnership with Johnson & Johnson and the National SAFE KIDS Campaign, will promote the theme of "Follow the Leader, Safety Starts with You" during National SAFE KIDS Week 2005 because research shows children are more likely to practice good safety tactics when they learn from the positive actions of parents, caregivers and other adult influencers; and
- Whereas: National SAFE KIDS Week 2005 includes news conferences, safety fairs, school-based activities and other special events that feature drowning prevention, pedestrian safety, bike safety and/or child passenger safety, to assist in the overall mission of the National SAFE KIDS Campaign: keeping kids safe.
