
9. Background: Pelican Nest Drive is the southern entrance into the Pelican Landing Development of Regional Impact and is located in the City of Bonita Springs. The plat of Pelican Landing dedicated Pelican Nest Drive to the Pelican Landing Community Association, Inc. Thereafter, the road was transferred to the Bay Creek Community Development District via quit claim deed.

Pelican Nest Drive west of the gatehouse is currently owned and maintained by the Bay Creek Community Development District. The Pelican Land Community Association, Inc., desires to once again assume ownership and control of the road west of the gatehouse facility. As a condition of transferring ownership, the Community Development District has requested confirmation that the County has no interest in the roadway west of the gatehouse as part of the County roadway network.

The interlocal agreement between Lee County and the City of Bonita Springs, approved by the Board of County Commissioners on September 19, 2000, did not identify Pelican Nest Drive as a road whose jurisdiction was transferred to the City.

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RELATING TO PELICAN'S NEST DRIVE WEST OF THE EXISTING GATEHOUSE

WHEREAS, the Board of Lee County Commissioners is the governing body in and for Lee County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Creek Community Development District is an independent special district which is a local unit of special purpose government created by and established pursuant to Florida Statutes, Chapter 190, the "Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980;" and

WHEREAS, the Pelican Landing Community Association, Inc. (PLCA) is a Florida corporation not-for-profit, which is formed to hold title to common elements within the Pelican landing community for the benefit of the community's residents; and

WHEREAS, the PLCA and Bay Creek Community Development District wish to transfer the ownership and control of Pelican's Nest Drive from the existing gatehouse to the west from the Community Development District to the PLCA; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development District desires that Lee County confirm whether it has an interest in Pelican's Nest Drive west of the existing gatehouse as part of the county roadway network; and

WHEREAS, Lee County does not have an interest in the road west of the existing gatehouse and, therefore, consents to the adoption of a resolution to that effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County. Florida, that:

1. Lee County does not object to the transfer of the ownership and control of Pelican's Nest Drive from the Bayside Community Development District to the Pelican Landing Community Association, Inc. in the area depicted on the attached exhibit "A" more specifically west of the existing gatehouse facility.
