## RESOLUTION

Whereas: On April 25, 2005, Kent A. Crappell, a crane operator with Boh Bros.

Construction on the Sanibel Causeway Improvements Project, was driving a concrete pile near the Causeway's drawbridge and toll booth

plaza; and

Whereas: Failure of the concrete pile made the crane unstable; and

Whereas: Mr. Crappell displayed the presence of mind, quick thinking, and

proficiency with the crane to warn his co-workers by blowing the air horn, and steer the falling concrete pile and crane in a way to minimize the danger to nearby motorists and bridge construction workers. Only one person, other than Mr. Crappell, suffered injuries due to the

accident; and

Whereas: In performing this selfless act, Mr. Crappell sacrificed his own life as he

was thrown from the crane's cab; and

Whereas: Lee County and its citizens owe a debt of gratitude to Mr. Crappell for

his heroism. It is right and fitting that during National Public Works Week, May 15<sup>th</sup> through 21<sup>st</sup>, we honor Mr. Crappell and the tens of thousands of men and women in North America who provide and maintain the infrastructure and services collectively known as public works, in often high risk and potentially life-threatening situations.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida does hereby extend our deepest condolences to the family of Mr. Kent Crappell, and also our heartfelt appreciation for his selfless act that cost him his life, but saved the lives

of others.
