9. Background:

On April 3, 2001, the Board of County Commissioners approved the award of RFQ-01-04 COUNTY-WIDE CONTINUING CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT with a total of ten (10) Construction Management firms. Approved under this blue sheet, each projects Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) will be brought back for Board approval.

The lighting at Bayshore Elementary is being replaced since they were damaged as a result of Hurricane Charley. Risk Management is working through the County's insurance to have the insurance pay for those costs that qualify for reimbursement.

Therefore, it is being recommended that the Board approve Construction Manager Addendum under RFQ-01-04 COUNTY-WIDE CONTINUING CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, for the project known as Bayshore Elementary School Lighting Replacement with a Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$370,510.00 (includes CM fee of \$30,592.63) to Lodge Construction, Inc. Also request that the Board approve waiving of the formal process (if needed) and authorize the use of the Direct Material Purchase Orders as provided for in the CM agreement with Lee County, which allows the County to purchase directly from suppliers of equipment and/or materials as a cost/time saving measure.


Because of the large amount and variety of construction projects expected to be needed during the year, staff worked to develop a procedure that will decrease the time required to bid out projects individually and provide a variety on Construction Management firms the ability to work on County projects with a dollar amount of \$50,000.00 to \$1,000,000.00 on an as-needed-basis.

In order for the County to take advantage of saving the sales tax and as a time saving measure we are requesting authorization to purchase materials from various vendors selected by the construction manager and the County.


