9. Background:

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for a Toll Violation Enforcement System.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was May 6, 2005. A total of three (3) Letters of Interest were submitted by the established deadline. All three (3) Letters of Interest were considered at the Competitive Negotiations Committee meeting on May 11, 2005. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of Jim Lavender, Public Works Director, Chairman, Paul Wingard, Deputy Director, DOT, and Carol Goldwasser, DOT Tolls Director. Based on the information submitted by all three (3) firms, it was the consensus of the Committee to invite all three (3) firms for written and oral presentations.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in the Letters of Interest and after conducting oral presentations on May 25, 2005, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Board the following order of ranking of Consultants: (1) VESystems Corporation; (2) TransCore; (3) InTrans Group, Inc.

The negotiated Agreement will be brought back to the Board for approval.


