- ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Concur with the ranking of Consultants by the Competitive Negotiations Committee for CN-05-17 ORTIZ AVENUE FOUR LANING, in the following order of ranking, and authorize contract negotiations to commence with the number one ranked firm: (1) AIM Engineering & Surveying, Inc.; (2) Dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precourt, Inc.; (3) Kisinger Campo & Associates.
- 2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provides Lee County with a Consultant for the four-laning of Ortiz Avenue from Martin Luther King (MLK) Jr. Boulevard (S.R. 82) to Palm Beach Boulevard (S.R. 80). This project includes survey and right-of-way maps, roadway plans, utility coordination and production of utility relocation plans, access management plans, lighting and signal design, bridge design (widening), preparation of cost estimates, bid documents, contract documents and obtaining all the government permits necessary for the construction of this project.

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Department of Transportation for professional services for the Ortiz Avenue Four Laning project.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was June 30, 2005. A total of eight (8) Letters of Interest were submitted by the established deadline. All eight (8) Letters of Interest were considered at the Competitive Negotiations Committee meeting on July 6, 2005. The Competitive Negotiations Committee considered of the following staff members: Scott Gilbertson, Director, Lee County DOT, Appointed Chairman, Eyra Cash, Project Manager, Lee County DOT and Don DeBerry, Lee County DOT. Based on the information submitted by Consultants in their Letter of Interest, it was the consensus to invite three (3) firms for written and oral presentations.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in their Letters of Interest and after conducting oral presentations on July 18, 2005 with the "short list" firms, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Board the following order of ranking of Consultants: (1) AIM Engineering and Surveying; (2) Dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precourt; (3) Kisinger Campo & Associates.

The negotiated Agreement will be brought back to the Board for approval.
