## 1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE:

#### 9. Background:

On June 28, 2005, The Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 05-06-73 approving the Residential and Commercial Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Rates for Fiscal Year 2005-2006. The adopted Resolution provided only an estimate for the Cape Coral Disposal Facilities MSTU millage. Estimated millage rate for the Cape Coral MSTU was 0.1355 mills; Final millage rate is 0.1301 mills.

Lee County Ordinances 00-20 and 96-09, both as amended, Fla. Admin. Code R. 12D-18.006, and Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes (2003) require adoption and certification by Resolution, the Residential and Commercial Solid Waste Annual Assessment Roll, Disposal Facilities Special Assessment Roll, and MSTU Tax roll for collection by the Lee County Tax Collector for Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County is the governing body in and for Lee County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Lee County Ordinance 86-14, as amended and restated by Lee County Ordinances 00-20 and 96-09, as may be amended or revised from time to time, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County is required to certify the Residential and Commercial Mandatory Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Annual Special Assessment Roll, Disposal Facilities Special Assessment Roll, and MSTU Tax Roll to the Lee County Tax Collector for collection of the Annual Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Assessments and MSTU Millage; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners on this date to adopt and certify the Residential and Commercial Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Annual Special Assessment Roll, Facilities Special Assessment Roll and MSTU Tax Roll to the Lee County Tax Collector for collection of the Annual Assessments and MSTU Millage for the period from October 1, 2005, through and including September 30, 2006, such Special Assessments to be collected by the Lee County Tax Collector pursuant to the Uniform Method for Collection of Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessments under Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes (2004); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has previously approved Lee County Resolution No. 05-06-73 estimating the Cape Coral Disposal Facilities MSTU millage for Fiscal Year 2005-2006; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners on this date to establish the final millage rate for the Cape Coral Disposal Facilities MSTU for Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

#### **SECTION ONE**

The Residential and Commercial Mandatory Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Annual Special Assessment Roll, Disposal Facilities Assessment Roll, and MSTU Tax Roll as developed by the Lee County Property Appraiser pursuant to Lee County Resolution No. 05-06-73 are hereby officially adopted and certified to the Lee County Tax Collector for the collection of the Annual Special Assessments and MSTU Millage, pursuant to the Uniform Method of Collection for Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessments under Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes (2004).

### **SECTION TWO**

The annual Cape Coral MSTU millage rate is hereby adopted as 0.1301 mills for Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

## **SECTION THREE**

The effective period for the collection of the Special Assessments and MSTU Millage pursuant to the certified Residential and Commercial Assessment Rolls and MSTU Tax Roll, shall be from October 1, 2005, through and including September 30, 2006, and which shall also include all new certified structures added to the Assessment Rolls or MSTU Tax Roll during that period.

## **SECTION FOUR**

This certification shall be accomplished by this Resolution and Florida Department of Revenue Form DR-408A (executed original attached hereto as Exhibit "A"), pursuant to Fla. Admin. Code R. 12D-18.006 (January 2004).

## **SECTION FIVE**

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
