RESOLUTION**

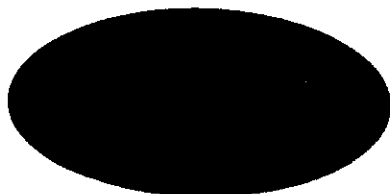
