

**Lee County Board Of County Commissioners
Agenda Item Summary**

Blue Sheet No. 20051159

1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Approve the award of Project EX050690, the purchase of Laboratory Equipment, for Utilities and other County Departments on an as needed basis at Florida State Contract pricing. Current expenditures are exceeding \$50,000 for the current fiscal year. Florida State Contract 490-000-03-1 is in effect until April 30, 2006. Approval is also requested for Utilities and other departments to purchase from this contract for as long as it is in place; and from any new state contracts that would replace this current contract once it expires. . Countywide expenditures are estimated to be approximately \$100,000 annually. Funding will come from the individual division's budget and they will be responsible for monitoring their own expenditures.

2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Authorizes Utilities and other departments to exceed the \$50,000 limit for purchasing Laboratory Equipment.

CONTRACTOR(S): Fisher Scientific Company L.L.C.

- A. AUTHORITY - Upon affirmative action taken by the State of Florida Department of Management Services, a contract has been executed between the State of Florida and the designated contractors.
- B. EFFECT - This contract was entered into to provide economies in the purchase of Laboratory Supplies and Equipment, by all State of Florida agencies and institutions. Therefore, in compliance with Section 287.042, Florida Statutes, all purchases of these commodities shall be made under the terms, prices, and conditions of this contract and with the suppliers specified.
- C. ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS - All purchase orders shall be issued in accordance with the attached ordering instructions. Purchaser shall order at the prices indicated, exclusive of all Federal, State and local taxes.
- All contract purchase orders shall show the State Purchasing contract number, product number, quantity, description of item, with unit prices extended and purchase order totaled. (This requirement may be waived when purchase is made by a blanket purchase order.)
- D. CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE - Agencies shall report any vendor failure to perform according to the requirements of this contract on Complaint to Vendor, form PUR 7017. Should the vendor fail to correct the problem within a prescribed period of time, then form PUR 7029, Request for Assistance, is to be filed with this office.
- E. SPECIAL AND GENERAL CONDITIONS - Special and general conditions are enclosed for your information. Any restrictions accepted from the supplier are noted on the ordering instructions.
- F. CONTRACT APPRAISAL FORM - State Contract Appraisal, form PUR 7073 should be used to provide your input and recommendations for improvements in the contract to State Purchasing for receipt no later than 90 days prior to the expiration date of this contract.

2.01 Price Adjustments:

Price adjustments during the contract period are permitted using the following criteria:

Contractor will only be allowed to increase prices on the contract anniversary date (The last date signed Section 4.0 Bid Forms CONTRACT) for each year the contract is in place. Contractors must notify the Department of any intended price increase at least 60 days before the anniversary date of the contract. Any price increase is not to exceed the finished goods Producer Price Index in the event the index increases by more than 3%. The Department reserves the right to accept or reject any price increases.

Price decreases will be accepted at any time during this contract.

2.03 Technical Documentation:

Contractor shall be required to furnish to State of Florida eligible users, net price lists, descriptive literature, technical data and service information for items awarded. Bidders are urged to reserve approximately 1,000 price lists for this purpose, or as a preferred alternative, to provide a Contractor maintained online website to which the contract can be linked.

2.04 Occupational Health and Safety:

In compliance with Chapter 442, Florida Statutes, any item delivered from a contract resulting from this solicitation must be accompanied by a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS). The MSDS must be maintained by the user agency and must include the following information:

- The chemical name and the common name of the toxic substance.
- The hazards or other risks in the use of the toxic substance, including:
 - a. The potential for fire, explosion, corrosivity, and reactivity;
 - b. The known acute and chronic health effects of risks from exposure, including the medical conditions which are generally recognized as being aggravated by exposure to the toxic substance; and
 - c. The primary routes of entry and symptoms of overexposure.
- The proper precautions, handling practices, necessary personal protective equipment, and other safety precautions in the use of or exposure to the toxic substances, including appropriate emergency treatment in case of overexposure.
- The emergency procedure for spills, fire, disposal, and first aid.
- A description in lay terms of the known specific potential health risks posed by the toxic substance intended to alert any person reading this information.
- The year and month, if available, that the information was compiled and the name, address, and emergency telephone number of the manufacturer responsible for preparing the information.

2.05 Delivery and Minimum Order

- **Packaging:** Units shall be packaged in accordance with manufacturer's standard packaging requirements which shall be adequate to ensure safe delivery to destination.
- **Marking for Shipment:** Each container shall be marked to include the following information:
 - Contractor's Name
 - Purchase Order Number
 - Item Description
- **Delivery and Installation Requirements:** All prices bid shall include delivery to purchaser within 21 days after receipt of purchase order.

Prices offered to the Agencies and Political Subdivisions apply to all eligible users and will include all freight charges except in those instances where supply orders total less than \$300.00. For orders totaling less than \$300.00 the contractor may elect to invoice for freight charges as a separate item.

2.06 Acceptable Equipment

Contractor must provide new equipment currently in production in a manufacturer's facility.

Remanufactured, discontinued, rebuilt, reconditioned, refurbished, used, shopworn, demonstrator, or prototype equipment is not acceptable and shall be rejected.

It is understood that the State will benefit from any revisions, alterations, additions, technical improvements, or necessary modifications in the units offered during the term of this contract at no additional cost.

2.07 Substitution

Prior written approval of the Contract Administrator is required for substitution of equipment. The State retains sole discretion to accept and approve such requests when deemed to be in the State's best interest. The State reserves the right to accept a product deemed by the Contract Administrator to be equivalent to the specified commodity. The State recognizes that technology is changing rapidly; therefore, on such models a determination as to acceptability will be done on a case-by-case basis. All substitutes shall be offered at the awarded price or lower.
