On August 17, 2004, the Board of County Commissioners approved the award of CN-04-14 MISCELLANEOUS UTILITY ENGINEERING DESIGN AND/OR INSPECTION SERVICES with a total of nineteen (19) firms: Barraco & Associates, Inc.; Ray Boyd; Boyle Engineering Corp.; CH2M Hill; CPH Engineers, Inc.; Carollo Engineers; Q. Grady Minor & Associates, PA; Greeley & Hansen; Hazen & Sawyer; Hole Montes, Inc.; Ink Engineering; JRI Engineering, Inc.; Johnson Engineering, Inc.; MWH Americas, Inc.; Malcolm Pirnie, Inc.; PBS & J, Inc.; Pitman-Hartenstein & Associates, Inc.; Source, Inc.; WilsonMiller, Inc. for a contract period of two (2) years with the option of renewal for one (1) additional year.

SCOPE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

For Misc. Utility Engineering Design and/or Inspection Services

SECTION 1.00 CHANGE(S) TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The "Scope of Professional Services" as set forth in Exhibit "A" of the Professional Services Agreement, or Service Provider Agreement, referred to hereinbefore is hereby supplemented, changed or authorized, so that the CONSULTANT or SERVICE PROVIDER, shall provide and perform the following professional services, tasks, or work as a supplement to, change to, or authorized to, the scope of services previously agreed to and authorized:

BASIC SERVICES

GENERAL SCOPE STATEMENT

It is anticipated that Lee County Utilities (LCU) will enter into a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to relocate certain utilities which may be in conflict with the proposed I-75 Daniels Road Interchange Improvements. The FDOT design consultant for this project is ParsonBrinckerhoff.

The relocation efforts will involve the following utilities:



- Approximately 3,500 LF of 30-inch waterline, to be increased to a 42-inch waterline, including a casing pipe.
- Approximately 3,500 LF of 24-inch casing pipe for an alternate future forcemain crossing.
- Evaluation may include consideration of horizontal directional drilling (HDD) technology.

It is the intent of LCU to have the design relocation plans prepared using Micro-Station, which is compatible with FDOT's efforts. Final drawings will also be provided in ACAD format upon completion.

At this time, no survey or subsurface utility engineering or geotechnical services are anticipated as part of the water main relocation design effort as the FDOT Roadway Design Consultant will provide the base drawing.

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SCOPE OF SERVICES

Daniels Road 30-inch Water Main Relocation

TASK 1.0 60% Design Review

- 1.0.1 Upon receipt of the 60% (Basic Plan) from FDOT through Lee County, review the Plan for conflicts with the utility realignments caused by drainage structures, walls, light pole foundations and other reasonably definable subsurface obstructions such as signal cables.
- 1.0.2 The listing of anticipated relocations and utility adjustments will be performed using the FDOT Utility Work Schedule as shown below:

- 1.0.3 Using the FDOT drawings, prepare a "RGB Utility Markup", where "Red" represents the utility to be removed, "Green" represents the utility to remain and "Brown" represents the proposed utility. Upon concurrence by LCU, submit to FDOT.
- 1.1 60% Utility Plans Project Management
 - 1.1.1 This task includes preparing communications, meeting with the client to review the 60% design, advancing the design to the final bid package and quality assurance coordination
 - 1.1.2 Coordination with FDOT consultant to ensure compatibility with roadway contract documents
- 1.2 60% Utility Plans
 - 1.2.1 Based upon the approval of the utilities to be relocated and adjusted, prepare Utility Relocation Adjustment plans. These plans will include profile views of utility mains and select roadway crossings.
 - 1.2.2 Include details of valves and appurtenant facilities, based on Lee County Utilities Standard Details. The roadway plans prepared by FDOT's roadway consultant will be the base plans for this work.
 - 1.2.3 The 60% submittal will be two 11" x 17" hard copy set of plans.

TASK 2.0 90% Utility Plans

- 2.0.1 A period of review will follow the 60% submittal. The review comments from the 60% to 90% will be incorporated to advance the plan, profiles and details (including RGB markups/ and updating the Utility Work Schedule) to the 90% level of completion.
- 2.0.2 Changes will also be made that correspond to revisions in the FDOT roadway and drainage design from 60% to 90% level, as appropriate.
- 2.0.3 The 90% submittal will be one hard copy set of plans.

TASK 3.0 100 % Utility Plans

- 3.0.1 The review from the 90% to 100% will be incorporated to prepare the Utility Relocation Adjustment plans to 100% design.
- 3.0.2 Communications will be included to convey the sequence of abandoning existing utility mains and construction of new utility main(s).
- 3.0.3 Quantities calculations will be performed and will be incorporated into the development of an Engineers Opinion of Probable Construction Cost.
- 3.0.4 The Technical Special Provisions for the design will be prepared using the Standard Lee County Specifications in an FDOT-acceptable format. Lee County Utilities will provide WilsonMiller with standard specifications in FDOT format to incorporate into the project.
- 3.0.5 These Plans will also include details of valves and appurtenant facilities, based on the standard Lee County Utilities Details.
- 3.0.6 The 100% submittal will be two 11" x 17" hard copy set of plans, technical special provisions and updating the Utility Work Schedule.

TASK 4.0 Final Utility Plans, Bid & Construction Documents

- 4.0.1 After verification of the 100% submittal, the relocation and adjustment plans will be finalized with the Technical Special Provisions to be part of the bid package.
- 4.0.2 Bid packages will be prepared separately from the FDOT Roadway Improvements.
- 4.0.3 The design plans, specifications, and Engineers Opinion of Probable Construction Cost will be prepared with a bid schedule. The bid schedule will be prepared for bidding as a joint project with the FDOT project.
- 4.0.4 It is understood that Lee County Utilities will make reproductions of the plans for bidding purposes. Therefore, only one set of hard copy plans and bid documents along with electronic files (ACAD format) of the same will be submitted as project final documents.

TASK 5.0 Perm	itting
5.0.1	This task will involve the preparation of the following permit applications and supporting documentation:
	a. FDOH Potable Water Construction Permitb. FDEP Wastewater Construction Permitc. LCU Right-of-Way Permits.
	It is recognized by the OWNER that permitting is a regulatory function and CONSULTANT does not guarantee issuance any permit.
5.0.2	However, CONSULTANT will provide assistance if resolving permitting issues with the concurrence of LCU.
