Lee County and the owners and developers of the North Point DRI propose to enter into a development agreement that outlines the mitigation protocol for the transportation impacts of the DRI. The proposed mitigation will include the payment of money, impact fees, and the construction of certain improvements to Sandy Lane. Florida law mandates that a local government hold two public hearings before entering into a development agreement pursuant to Florida Statutes.
