9. Background:		

The schedule specified in Article X, Paragraph 10.07 of the State Revolving Fund Loan Agreement (per Amendment No. 2) calls for a Loan Repayment Reserve Account and a Loan Debt Service Account to be established by January 15<sup>th</sup> 2006. Monthly deposits to the Loan Debt Service Account equal to 1/6<sup>th</sup> of the Semi-annual Payment are also to commence by January 15, 2006; and Certifications under Subsection 2.01(12) are to start by April 15, 2006.

In response to LCU's request, the FDEP has granted Lee County a one-year extension to complete preconstruction activities. Therefore, the required Amendment No. 3 is attached, and being submitted for approval.

Lee County Utilities is preparing to initiate two projects, Expansion of the Gateway WWTP to 3 MGD, and the Airport Sewer District Transmission line, that are part of preconstruction loan agreement CS12039232P. In the next 3 months Lee County Utilities will submit all documents still pending to comply with the "Readiness to Proceed Requirements", an updated RFI and; subsequently, a construction loan application.

The referenced Preconstruction Loan Agreement – CS12039232P calls for the repayment schedule to begin on January 15, 2006. Since the revised RFI cannot be considered until the January hearing and the finalization of a construction loan would not occur until after the project is put on the fundable portion, we hereby respectfully request a 6-month extension of the start date of the repayment schedule.

The 6-month extension requested would provide enough time to complete submittal of all required project documentation and to roll the preconstruction loan into the construction loan. This would simplify and reduce both FDEP and Lee County Utilities' efforts and the costs required to manage the SRF loan and repayments.

### STATE REVOLVING FUND AMENDMENT 3 TO LOAN AGREEMENT CS12039232P LEE COUNTY

This amendment is executed by the STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (Department) and LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, existing as a local government agency (Local Government) under the laws of the State of Florida.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Department and the Local Government entered into a State Revolving Fund Loan Agreement, Number CS12039232P; and

WHEREAS, Loan repayment activities need rescheduling to give the Local Government additional time to complete preconstruction activities, and

WHEREAS, the Loan Repayment Reserve Account is no longer required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Unless repayment is further deferred by amendment of the Agreement, Semiannual Loan Payments as set forth in Section 10.05 shall be received by the Department beginning on July 15, 2007, and semiannually thereafter on January 15 and July 15 of each year until all amounts due under the Agreement have been fully paid.
- 2. The requirement for a Loan Repayment Reserve Account is deleted. All references in the Agreement to the Loan Repayment Reserve are no longer applicable.
- 3. The items scheduled under Subsections 10.07 (6) and (7) of the Agreement are rescheduled as follows:
  - (6) Unless deferred by amendment, establish the Loan Debt Service Account and begin Monthly Loan Deposits no later than January 15, 2007.
  - (7) Unless deferred by amendment, provide certifications under Subsection 2.01(12) beginning April 15, 2007, and thereafter, no later than September 30 of each year until the final Semiannual Loan Repayment is made.

All other terms and provisions of the Loan Agreement shall remain in effect.
