- Whereas:** in 2004 Lee County was impacted by three hurricanes, Charley, Frances and Jeanne; and
- Whereas:** Lee County residents submitted over 35,000 disaster claims to the Federal Emergency Management; and
- Whereas:** Lee County developed and implemented the Long Term Recovery Committee in partnership with the American Red Cross, United Way, Salvation Army, Harry Chapin Food Bank, United Methodist Committee, Lee County Emergency Operations Center and the Department of Human Services; and
- Whereas:** the Long Term Recovery Committee's mission is to coordinate the Federal, State and local resources efficiently and effectively without duplication of services; and
- Whereas:** the Long Term Recovery Committee provided services to 227 case units which included families and individuals that were either low income or received a fixed income and did not have insurance or sufficient insurance to repair the damages to their homes; and
- Whereas:** participation in long term recovery response from the faith based organizations are critical to the effectiveness of the social service delivery; and
- Whereas:** the Lutheran Disaster Services of Florida has generously donated \$50,000 to assist the 2004 hurricane victims that are still in need of services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida does hereby commend the Lutheran Services of Florida for their support and generosity to the Lee County residents impacted by the 2004 hurricanes.
