ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Award B-05-20 Disaster Debris Monitoring Services, for the Solid Waste Division, to the lowest average bidder, Solid Resources Inc., for the following hourly fees: Project Manager .95.00/hr; Field Coordinator \$80.00/hr; Field Monitoring/Staging Monitor/Crew Leader \$40.00/hr; Supervisor \$60.00/hr; and Data Entry \$35.00. Authorize Chairman to execute the Service Provider Agreement upon completion.
- 2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provide assistance to the Lee County Board of County Commissioners by providing Debris Removal Monitoring and Record-keeping services and shall include participation in meetings, workshops, and the establishment of data management and other integrated systems, as specified.

9. Background:

The Solid Waste Division submitted a request to Contracts Management to solicit bids for Disaster Debris Monitoring Services. The expected cost of the services required the use of the formal process.

On the bidding deadline of July 27, 2005 Contracts received four (4) bids. The bids were reviewed by the Solid Waste Division and a recommendation was received to award to the lowest average bidder, based on a comparative cost matrix, Solid Resources Inc. The chronology of events was as follows:

- September 7, 2005 Notice of Intent letters were faxed to all bidders indicating award to Solid Resources.
- September 10, 2005 a Notice of Intent to File a Protest was received from Engineered Resources.
- September 22, 2005 the Formal Written Protest was received from Engineered Resources.
- October 6, 2005, the "informal" protest hearing was held with the protester, Engineered Resources and the recommended awardee, Solid Resources". The Bid Dispute Committee consisted of the following staff members: Jim Lavender, Director of Public Works, as Chairman, Pete Winton, Assistant County Manager and Rick Diaz, Utilities Director. The invited participants: Lindsey Sampson, Solid Waste Director, Jason Fournier, Solid Waste and Scott Coovert, Legal Advisor.

FORMAL WRITTEN PROTEST FOR SOLICITATION B-05-20, DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING **SERVICES**

- Reference: 1. Engineering Resources, LLC letter, Bansi Patel to Jim Lavender, Notice of Intent to File a Protest for Solicitation B-05-20, Disaster Debris Monitoring Services, dated September 10, 2005.
 - 2. Lee County Contracts Management letter, Cindy Logan to Bansi Patel, "Disaster Debris Monitoring Services", dated September 7, 2005.

Dear Mr. Lavender,

As required in your Contracts Management Procedure Manual, Administrative Code, AC-4-2 Bid Protest Hearing Guide, Section 12: "Bid/Proposal Protest Procedure", the following information is provided.

According to the 12.1 Bid/Proposal Protest Procedure, 7 indicates that any firm submitting the County's standard bond form (CMO:001) along with the bid is not required to submit an additional bond with the filing of the Formal Written Protest. Upon submission of the Engineered Resources, L.L.C. (ERLLC) bid for Solicitation B-05-20, Disaster Debris Monitoring Services, on July 27, 2005, a cash bond for \$2,500.00 along with Lee County's Standard Bond From (CMO:001) was included.

The disputed issues are stated below:

- 1. ERLLC is unclear as to the criteria used to award this contract. It appears that other objectives and criteria were applied that were not clearly identified in the Solicitation.
- 2. It is suspect that Solid Resources, Inc. is the "average lower bidder" overall and the most qualified to perform the required scope of work.
- 3. The matrix used by Contract Management was not provided in the original solicitation nor was this information shared with ERLLC. The matrix for Position A and B should have been available prior to the award, but when we posed the price structure question to Contractor Management we never received a response. Also, it is unclear where the Committee got its figures from or whether they are representative of the work.

4. It appears that one category was arbitrarily singled out to make the "average lower bidder" determination. ERLLC was overall the lowest bidder with the experience to back up the cost figures and man-hours necessary to complete the job. Nowhere in Solicitation No. B-05-20 was it explained how these cost figures would be evaluated and weighed by the Committee.

In light of the issues raised concerning the fair evaluation practices used to determine the "lowest average bidder", ERLLC requests that Contract Management re-bid the contract after first adding the matrix they intend to use to award the contract.

Also, we would like a clarification of, "Discrepancies in the multiplication of units of Work and unit prices will be resolved in favor of the unit price. Discrepancies between the indicated sum of any column of figures and the correct sum thereof will be resolved in favor of the correct sum".

Our pricing structure was based on other successful projects that came in well below budget and without injuries to our workers or the community. ERLLC is the best choice for this contract due to our expertise in municipal solid waste removal, emergency preparedness activities, and environmental/engineering experience.
