9. Background:

The East County Water Control District is planning to construct, own and operate community park, a.k.a Eco Park, located in Lehigh Acres (Property boundaries comprising approximately 2.62 acres are as follows: North boundary Fifth Street, East boundary is Ladyfish Canal, South boundary is Lee Blvd., and West boundary is Xelda Ave., Lehigh Acres).

In order to apply for a State grant, the jurisdiction of which the specified power is to be exercised (Lee County), must submit a letter of "no objection" for their grant application to obtain funds so that the District may plan, construct, equip, operate and maintain facilities for Eco Park as an outdoor recreational, cultural and educational use.
