9. Background:

On August 2, 2005 at a Special Public Hearing, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) provided direction to the Department of Transportation after adopting the "western alignment" as the preferred corridor for the alignment of County Road 951 Corridor Study for the purpose of forwarding the selected alignment to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for evaluation against the "no build" alternative. Based on public input at the Special Public Hearing that there was another alternative to the "western alignment", the BOCC indicated they would consider additional information on other alignments, if brought forward within sixty (60) day from the Public Hearing.

Within the sixty (60) days window provided by the BOCC, two (2) letters were received - Edison Farms, Inc. on September 23, 2005 and Talon Management on September 24, 2005. On October 25, 2005, the BOCC considered the submitted letters relating to the alternative alignments. The BOCC directed staff to contact Edison Farms, Inc. and obtain their detailed offer and bring that offer back to the BOCC on November 15, 2005. Talon Management's offer was rejected.

Based on the BOCC's direction, the staff is bringing this item back for further consideration and direction.
