SECTION 1.00 SCOPE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

SECTION 2.00 COMPENSATION

3.02 Task Authorizations

Following the execution of this SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, by both parties, the AUTHORITY shall issue the CONSULTANT a written Task Authorization. Following the issuance of such Task Authorization, the CONSULTANT shall be authorized to commence work and shall commence work promptly and shall carry on all such services, tasks and work as may be required in a continuous, diligent, and forthright manner to expeditious completion.

SECTION 5.00 PROJECT GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

SECTION 6.00 PROHIBITED INTERESTS

No member, officer or employee of the Port Authority or of the locality during his tenure or for one year thereafter shall have any interest, direct or indirect, in this Agreement or the proceeds thereof.

SECTION 7.00 LOBBYING CERTIFICATION

The CONSULTANT agrees that no Federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid by or on behalf of the CONSULTANT, to any person for influencing or attempting to influence any officer or employee of any Federal agency, a Member of Congress in connection with the awarding of any Federal contract, the making of any Federal grant, the making of any Federal loan, the entering into of any cooperative agreement, and the extension, continuation, renewal, amendment or modification of any Federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement.

If any funds other than Federal appropriated funds have been paid by the CONSULTANT to any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any Federal agency, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with this Agreement, the undersigned shall complete and submit Standard Form-LLL, "Disclosure Form to Report Lobbying," in accordance with its instructions.

Task 78 - RSW Interspace Airport Advertising

I. OBJECTIVE

To provide construction administration services related to the procurement and installation of advertising displays and scrolling advertising signage at the Terminal Complex at the Southwest Florida International Airport.

II. DESCRIPTION

The CONSULTANT will provide construction administration services necessary for the development of the procurement and installation of approximately eleven (11) LCD advertising displays and twelve (12) scrolling advertising signage displays to be located throughout the terminal.

III. BASIC SERVICES

The CONSULTANT shall perform the following tasks:

- A. Attend and participate in one preconstruction conference.
- B. Respond to questions regarding the design intent usually formalized as Requests for Information (RFI's).
- C. Attend bi-weekly construction meetings and visit the site as needed to resolve outstanding issues and observe the construction progress and general character and quality of the work. Further, CA tasks will include review of the Contractor's monthly and final applications for payment and recommend acceptance or adjustments of payments in accordance with the contract documents.
- D. Review and approve any and all Change Orders and Field Directives as requested by the Port Authority.
- E. Provide technical assistance to the CM/GC during construction.
- F. Attend the substantial completion and final inspection(s) and prepare and check punch lists.
- G. Provide final certification that the project was constructed in conformance with the contract documents.

IV. SCHEDULE

The construction schedule is 90-calendar days through substantial completion and 30-calendar days to final completion.

V. PROJECT BUDGET

The total project budget for this project is \$659,209.

VI. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Any request for additional fees shall be submitted in writing to the Port Authority Project Manager prior to any work performed.

VII. FEE

The fee for this task is a lump sum amount for Construction Administration Services. The fees also include, but are not limited to, reimbursement for trips, long distance telephone calls, facsimiles, direct expenses, postage, delivery, computer plots and work printing.
