## 9. BACKGROUND:

Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for the project known as CN-05-22 COUNTY-WIDE ENVIRONMENTAL CONTRACT.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was September 12, 2005. A total of fourteen (14) Letters of Interest were received by the established deadline.
