9. Background:

Dear David:

As you have requested, this letter presents a proposal for our firm to provide special legal consulting services to Lee County Board of County Commissioners for the 2006 Regular Session, and any extended or special session as may be deemed necessary.

It is our understanding that the County desires advice and special legal assistance on several local issues that are expected to be considered in the Legislature. To assist the County, we propose to provide the special legal consultant services as directed by you on issues of interest to the County including, but not limited to, impact fees, growth management, charter county preemption, solid waste, and ad valorem tax reform.

As to compensation for our services for the Regular Session and the time period for the Governor's consideration, which commences March 7, 2006, we suggest a flat fee of \$30,000, inclusive of expenses. The suggested flat fee is intended to cover the anticipated time required in addressing the multiplicity and legal complexity of the issues.

We propose to bill the County in four equal installments. The first will be mailed upon receiving Board approval of the terms for our services. The final three installments on the fifteenth of the succeeding months thereafter (April 15, May 15, and June 15).

It has been with great professional satisfaction that we have served Lee County through the provision of special legal consulting services in past Session. We anticipate that the challenge presented by the issues in the 2006 Session will prove equally rewarding.
