# Lee County Board Of County Commissioners Agenda Item Summary

### 1. Action Requested/Purpose:

Approve acceptance of payment to Lee County in the amount of \$6,060.48 from JG Gulf Coast Town Center, LLC or their managing agent (CBL & Associates Management, Inc.) for County staff to fabricate and install standard highway "Guide Signs" and directional arrows within Lee County Right of Way. Motorists are provided with positive guidance to major destinations.

#### 2. What Action Accomplishes:

Provides for acceptance of the payment of the necessary funds. Payment of the \$6,060.48 covers the County's material costs, warehousing, labor, direct and indirect costs (including benefit costs) as well as the estimated maintenance costs for the life of the signs. Utilizing County forces insures that the signs are fabricated from the correct reflective materials, that the signs and posts are installed properly. Maintenance and replacement by County crews will be minimized and therefore crews can easily maintain the guide sign installation. County staff will not be required to ineur impacts on staff time for coordination of the project and inspections that would occur if a contractor were utilized.

## Background:

Gulf Coast Town Center will be a major destination and as such qualifies for destination signing using the guidelines for standard highway "Guide Signs". Gulf Coast Town Center has contracted with a traffic consultant to work with Lee County Department of Transportation (LCDOT) staff and to develop a plan for the "guide signs" and directional arrows to help motorists locate various destinations. During the preliminary engineering phase, many existing Guide Signs were found to need replacement in order to add the Gulf Coast Town Center destination, therefore Gulf Coast Town Center is required to pay for the replacement of the sign or relocate the existing sign to accommodate their destination. In total, 9 large Guide Signs will need to be fabricated and the necessary sign posts and sleeves purchased and installed. Gulf Coast Town Center has requested that Lee County fabricate and install the required signs. LCDOT has jurisdiction over the County Right of Way (R/W) and as such regulates who may work within the R/W and what may be placed in the R/W. It is in the County's best interest to fabricate and install these signs as this work is solely within County R/W and serves public purpose. County staff recommended that it would be more cost effective and more beneficial from a long-term maintenance standpoint to utilize County forces for the required work. Gulf Coast Town Center LLC/CBL & Associates Management, Inc. requested that Lee County fabricate and install the signs.
