1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Concur with the selection of the Qualification Selection Committee for RFQ-06-04, HURRICANE DEBRIS & VEGETATION REMOVAL IN THE WATERWAYS AND NATURAL CREEKS IN LEE COUNTY, and authorize staff to negotiate on a project-by-project basis with the following seven (7) firms: Crowder-Gulf Joint Venture, Inc.; DRC Emergency Services, LLP; Ecosystem Technologies, Inc.; Mettauer Environmental, Inc.; Phillips and Jordan, Inc.; TSI Disaster Recovery Services, Inc.; and WE Blackmon Construction Co., Inc. for the purpose of removing hurricane debris and vegetation in the waterways and natural creeks in Lee County on an as-needed basis. This is a three (3) year contract with a one (1) year renewal option. The annual amount of the contract is \$1,100,000.00. Authorize Chairwoman to execute the Service Provider Agreement upon completion.

9. BACKGROUND:
 Request for Qualifications were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for Lee County.

The deadline for receipt of the Qualification Submittals was March 14, 2006. A total of eight (8) submittals were received by the established deadline date. All eight (8) submittals were considered at the Qualification Selection Committee meeting held on March 22, 2006. The Qualification Selection Committee consisted of the following staff members: Jim Lavender, Director of Public Works, as Chairman; Allen Davies, Natural Resources, Project Manager; and Roland Ottolini, Director of Natural Resources. At the meeting, it was requested by the Committee that clarifications be received regarding submittals and that the Committee would reconvene for review of those clarifications and final evaluation. The Committee reconvened on March 24, 2006, and it was the consensus of the Committee to select seven (7) of the firms for contract: Crowder-Gulf Joint Venture, Inc.; DRC Emergency Services, LLP; Ecosystem Technologies, Inc.; Mettauer Environmental, Inc.; Phillips and Jordan, Inc.; TSI Disaster Recovery Services; and WE Blackmon Construction Co., Inc.
