SCOPE OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

for Three Oaks Parkway from 6,500± Feet North of Alico Road to Fiddlesticks Boulevard and Widening of Fiddlesticks Boulevard from Two (2) Lane to Four (4) Lane to Daniels Parkway.

SECTION 1.00 CHANGE(S) TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

The "Scope of Professional Services" as set forth in Exhibit "A" of the Professional Services Agreement, or Service Provider Agreement, referred to hereinbefore is hereby supplemented, changed or authorized, so that the CONSULTANT or SERVICE PROVIDER, shall provide and perform the following professional services, tasks, or work as a supplement to, change to, or authorized to, the scope of services previously agreed to and authorized:

Replace Section 1. General Scope statement with the following:

The CONSULTANT shall provide and perform the following professional services, which shall constitute the GENERAL SCOPE of the SERVICES under the covenants, terms and provisions of this PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT:

The CONSULTANT shall conduct surveys, prepare an environmental impact summary, prepare final plans and specification, cost estimates, bid documents, all government permit applications including storm water pollution prevention plan and EPA NOI, and coordinate all utility system adjustments, in accordance with permits, which may be required from the U.S. Army Corp. Of Engineers, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Florida Department of Natural Resources, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the South Florida Water Management District for the design of a four (4) lane, expandable to six (6) lane divided urban roadway from Indian Paint Lane; the design of a four (4) lane, expandable to six (6) lane divided urban roadway from Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway; the design of Indian Pony Drive and Indian Paint Lane, from Fiddlesticks Boulevard to 550 feet South of Daniels Parkway, as two lane local roads, with sidewalks; the design of an at-grade signalized intersections at Daniels Parkway and Indian Paint Lane; the design of two Box Culverts per the Treeline Avenue water management design. Revise roadway alignment to accommodate Southwest Florida International Airport / I-75 Interchange. Addition of street lighting from Indian Pony Lane to Gator Canal.

The final scope and extent of some Tasks cannot be determined at this time. These Tasks are designated as "Not To Exceed" (NTE). Upon determination, a Change Order to the Agreement shall adjust the NTE fees for these tasks.

The remaining Tasks have been modified to accommodate the following adjustments:

This Supplemental Task Agreement No. 3 is based on the following scope changes and circumstances:

- 1. Revising Three Oaks typical section from a rural section to an urban section to include curb and gutter, closed drainage, sidewalks and bike lane.
- Revise the alignment in the southern portion to avoid the future location of the Southwest Florida International Airport access interchange on I-75.
- 3. Revise the alignment in the northern portion to avoid the existing eagle nest.
- 4. Revise the alignment at Daniels Parkway intersection to reduce the R/W taking on the west side from 8 to 6 feet.
- 5. Revise The Indian Paint / Indian Pony intersection from a stop intersection to a curved transition.
- 6. Revise Indian Paint and Indian Pony to urban section to include curb and gutter, closed drainage, sidewalks and bike lane.
- 7. Revise the Palomino Street intersection to account for the new frontage road construction.
- 8. Add new lake near the Southwest Florida International Airport access interchange on I-75.
- 9. Add new culvert crossing for I-75 drainage.
- 10. Revise Three Oaks Parkway connection to the subdivision at the south end.
- 11. Revise survey to include new alignment and update planimetrics.
- 12. Include additional soil borings along new alignment and lake.

ITEM No. 1

Replace existing Project Guidelines and Criteria with the following:

The COUNTY has established the following Guidelines, Criteria, Goals, Objectives, Constraints, Schedule, Budget and/or Requirements, which shall serve as a guide to the CONSULTANT in performing the professional services and work to be provided pursuant to this Agreement:

The purpose of this document is to support the Project in sufficient detail that the CONSULTANT can follow the task descriptions and prepare the basis of compensation for services in sufficient detail to assure the COUNTY that all anticipated tasks necessary and the corresponding compensation required have been identified and defined by the CONSULTANT. The services provided by the CONSULTANT shall include all anticipated work necessary for the design and bidding phase of the project to ensure a complete competently designed, build-able and functional project. The services shall include all defined necessary studies and investigations, complete construction drawings, technical specifications, and contract documents, including all known necessary engineering surveys, right-of-way surveys, and maps and individual parcel survey plats and parcel descriptions, all necessary permits from the State and Federal agencies having jurisdictional authority over any aspect of the project. FDOT standard Maintenance of Traffic Plans are not required. Schematic Maintenance of Traffic Plans will include maintenance of driveway access and time of closures. Should changes in design standards, unforeseen or unanticipated scope of services, environmental regulations, and permitting requirements occur after execution of this Professional Service Agreement which substantially affect the effort required, compensation for additional effort will be negotiated.

The project will include the design of a four (4) lane, expandable to six (6) lane divided urban roadway from Indian Paint Lane to Daniels Parkway; the design of Indian Pony Drive and Indian Paint Lane, from Fiddlesticks Boulevard to 550 feet South of Daniels Parkway, as two lane local roads, with sidewalks; the design of an at-grade signalized intersections at Daniels Parkway and Indian Paint Lane; the design of two Box Culverts per the Treeline Avenue water management design. Revise roadway alignment to accommodate Southwest Florida International Airport / 1-75 Interchange. Addition of street lighting from Indian Pony Lane to Gator Canal.

CMO:029 09/25/01 The portion of Three oaks Parkway from Oriel (5,700 feet north of Alico Road) to 6,500 feet north of Alico Road, will be designed as a four (4) lane, expandable to six (6) lane divided urban roadway. The abutting roadway is being designed, including stormwater management for this portion of the Roadway, and permitted by the property owner. Modifications to the Development Order and permits may be required by the property owner.

Design, plans, specifications and contract documents shall be complete in scope and detail and shall conform to the appropriate English system of units version of the Florida Department of Transportation Standard Plans Preparation Manual, Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Standards referred to and recommended in the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials and other Lee County guidelines in force on the date the agreement is signed.

Conceptual Design and Design shall be in accordance with provision of the COUNTY Development Standards Ordinance and will be adequate to meet permit or approval requirements for governmental agencies having jurisdiction over this project, in force on the date the Agreement is approved by the COUNTY including, but not necessarily limited to U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and South Florida Water Management District. Treatment of roadway run-off and prevention of erosion and salutation of adjacent wetlands during construction shall be provided. Mitigation may be necessary for any wetland areas impacted by the roadway. Design to be based on the assumption that the County can secure deviations to the Development Standards Ordinance.

The Consultant shall provide planimetrics of the project area sufficient to define topographical details within the limits of the proposed roadway. Roadway cross-sections and existing off-site topography needed shall be produced using field survey.

The COUNTY shall provide stormwater studies of the Project's watershed and outfalls, which are being performed by others. Hydraulic analysis of the watershed is not included in this Projects scope.

The fees in this Scope of Services are based upon the design phase being completed before January 1, 2008. If the date is not meet due delays beyond the Consultants control, a Change Order shall be issued to adjust the fees.
