WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provides Lee County with a Contractor for the construction of two new potable water concrete ground storage tanks, each with a capacity of 2 MG and internal baffle walls. Also includes soil preparation and subsurface foundations, installation of piping and valves connecting existing piping to the storage tanks, electric and instrumentation for associated control valves, demolition of an existing reinforced concrete foundation, and general sitework and grading.
