A waiver has been requested because Transportable Internet, Inc. is the sole source for systems of this type. Authority is also requested to expend the funds necessary for the annual maintenance and internet subscription costs for the life of the system currently \$3,600 per year. Also authorize transfer of monies from the Government Communications Network (GCN) reserve fund to cover the full amount of this purchase.

When a disaster occurs, the DRU is connected to the customer's existing data network and the customer then has a fully operation telephone system. A factory trained technician is not required for deployment or system programming
