9. Background:

Request is made annually in order to remove uncollectible account balances from Lee County Utilities' (LCU) billing records.

Uncollectibles result when customers' bills remain unpaid for various reasons. The three most significant reasons the accounts remain unpaid are: 1) Closed customers not paying final bill amounts after security deposits are applied and collection agency action; 2) Legal action such as bankruptcy; 3) Sewer only enstomers who are not paying monthly sewer utility bills.

All accounts owing greater than \$10.00 have been forwarded to a contracted collection agency. Per current policy, amounts greater than \$2,500.00 are to be processed by the County Attorney's Office. Customers with closed accounts and unpaid balances less than \$10.00; closed between May 1, 2005 and April 30, 2006; are included in this write-off period. All closed accounts with unpaid balances of \$1.00 or more are mailed reminder notices. Fort Myers Beach sewer accounts are billed and administered by the Fort Myers Beach Public Works Services, Inc.

Account information will be retained until the Statute of Limitations period expires to ensure these customers are not granted future service until amounts are paid. Collection efforts shall continue during the Statute of Limitations period.

Fiscal year to date, between October 1, 2005 and June 30, 2006, \$142,593.90 of uncollected receivable was referred to a collection agency. The collection agency has collected \$48,727.54 this fiscal year as of June 30, 2006.
