1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Concur with the ranking of Consultants by the Competitive Negotiations Committee for CN-06-17 HOMESTEAD ROAD FROM SUNRISE BOULEVARD TO ALABAMA ROAD WIDENING DESIGN, in the following order of ranking and authorize contract negotiations with the number one ranked firm: (1) HDR Engineering, Inc.; (2) Dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precourt, Inc.; and (3) Stanley Consultants, Inc.

2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provides Lee County with a Consultant to develop the alignment/right-of-way requirements and roadway design plans to widen Homestead Road to a four lane roadway (expandable to six) from South of Sunrise Blvd. to North of Alabama Road.

9. Background:
Letters of Interest were solicited on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners for professional services for the Homestead Road From Sunrise Boulevard to Alabama Road Widening Design project.

The deadline for receipt of Letters of Interest was August 1, 2006. A total of eight (8) Letters of Interest were submitted by the established deadline. All eight (8) Letters of Interest were considered at the Competitive Negotiations Committee meeting on September 18, 2006. The Competitive Negotiations Committee consisted of: Jim Lavender, Public Works Director, Chairman, Scott Gilbertson, Director, DOT, and Sarah Clark, DOT, Project Manager. Based on the information submitted by all eight (8) firms, it was the consensus of the Committee to invite three (3) firms for written and oral presentations.

On the basis of the information submitted by the firms in the Letters of Interest and after conducting oral presentations on September 18, 2006, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Board the following order of ranking of Consultants: (1) HDR Engineering, Inc.; (2) Dyer, Riddle, Mills & Precourt, Inc.; and (3) Stanley Consultants, Inc.

The negotiated Agreement will be brought back to the Board for approval.
