- 1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Approve Supplemental Agreement No. 10, for RFQ-03-03 Sanibel Bridge & Toll Plaza Reconstruction, with Jacobs Construction Services, Inc. (Contract #2632) to include the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) in the amount of \$4,432,530.00 (includes Phase CM Fee of \$177,003.00) and the Construction Inspection Services in the amount of \$79,576.00 and \$75,000.00 Preconstruction Services. Also authorize Chairman to execute Supplemental Agreement on behalf of the Board. Approve budget amendment resolution in the amount of \$3,879,658.00 in the Transportation Facilities/Commercial Paper Sanibel Bridge Fund and amend the FY 07-11 CIP. Further, approve transfer from reserves in the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$1.3 million for the Punta Rassa Boat Ramp project and amend FY 07-11 CIP.
- **2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES:** Allows for additional scope for the following areas: additional Bridge B & C MOT, seawall allowance, roadway lighting, restrooms & Fish Cleaning Station, roadway on islands A & B, Toll Plaza intercom, security, access control & CCTV systems, Transcore Systems for Toll Plaza and preconstruction services for a new & renovated restroom facility between Ft Myers and Sanibel Island.

### 9. Background:

On October 7, 2003, the Board approved award to Jacobs Construction Services, Inc. for RFQ-03-03 Sanibel Bridge & Toll Plaza Reconstruction along with Cape Coral Toll Plaza, in the amount of six percent (6%) of the total construction cost and a preconstruction not-to-exceed amount of \$826,528.00, and also authorized staff to enter into a Construction Manager Agreement.

At this time, the Department of Transportation is requesting Board approve Supplemental Agreement No. 10 for a Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$4,432,530.00 (includes Phase CM Fee of \$177,003.00) and the Construction Inspection Services in the amount of \$79,576.00 and \$75,000.00 preconstruction services, to allow for additional Bridge B & C MOT, seawall allowance, roadway lighting, restrooms & Fish Cleaning Station, roadway on islands A & B, Toll Plaza intercom, security, access control & CCTV systems, Transcore Systems for Toll Plaza and preconstruction services for a new & renovated restroom facility between Ft Myers and Sanibel Island.

The transfer from reserves in the amount of \$1.3 million includes expenses related to parking for the Punta Rassa Boat Ramp approval in Supplemental Agreement No. 6.

### EXHIBIT E

### SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 10

This Supplemental Agreement (hereinafter, "SA") is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_, 2006 by and between LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter, "Owner"), and JACOBS CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC., a Delaware corporation, and licensed to conduct business in the State of Florida (hereinafter, "CM").

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Owner and CM have entered into an "Agreement Between Owner And Construction Manager" (hereinafter, the "Agreement") for construction management services for the Sanibel Bridges and Toll Plaza Reconstruction as well as the Cape Coral Toll Plaza Reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, capitalized terms used herein shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contemplates that the Project shall be undertaken in separate discrete Phases, and that a Supplemental Agreement shall be used to authorize and govern all work of a Phase; and

WHEREAS, as contemplated in the Agreement, the work authorized by this SA is governed by the terms of the Agreement, as supplemented by the terms of this SA;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

### ARTICLE 1. SCOPE OF WORK

1.1 <u>Phase Description</u>. The Phase of the Project authorized by this SA is described in summary form as follows:

Additional Scope for:

- Additional Bridge B and C MOT Requirements less Scope Reductions, and Revised Quantities
- Additional 150' seawall allowance
- Roadway Lighting Changes
- Time Extension for Transcore System Install for Temporary Facility
- Restrooms and Fish Cleaning Station
- Additional Roadway on Islands A and B

- Toll Plaza Intercom, Security, Access Control & CCTV Systems
- Transcore Systems for Toll Plaza
- Preconstruction Services for an Additional and Renovation of Restroom Facilities between Ft. Myers and Sanibel Island along with the Landscaping of Sanibel Island Causeway
- 1.2 <u>Project Plans and Specifications</u>. The Project Plans and Specifications that describe and define the work of this Phase are listed in Appendix 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 1.3 <u>Authorization</u>. The CM is authorized to commence performance of this Phase upon the Construction Commencement Date or the effective date of this SA, whichever occurs later (in either case, referred to hereinafter as the "Commencement Date").

# ARTICLE 2. COMPENSATION

- 2.1 Phase GMP. Subject to adjustments provided for in the Agreement, the Phase GMP associated with this SA is Four Million Four Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Five Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$4,432,530) for the Work described in Section 1.1 above. This Phase GMP is in addition to the previously authorized GMP for Bridges A, B & C and the Sanibel Toll Facility and Roadways (including CM Services and Fees) of \$125,885,372. The new Total GMP for Bridges A, B and C and the Sanibel Toll Facility and Roadways is now One Hundred Thirty Million Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Nine Hundred and Two Dollars (\$130,317,902). [ref. Agreement Subparagraph 3.01(2)(a)]
- 2.2 <u>Phase CM Fees</u>. Pursuant to the revisions outlined in Article 4 and Appendix 4 of SA #5, the CM Fees are established as follows:
- 2.2.1 CM Fixed Fee. Subject to adjustments provided for in the Agreement, the Phase CM Fixed Fee associated with this SA is One Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand and Three Dollars (177,003). This Phase CM Fixed Fee is in addition to the previously authorized CM Fixed Fee for Bridges A, B & C of \$6,501,220. The new total CM Fixed Fee for Bridges A, B and C and the Sanibel Toll Facility and Roadways is now Six Million Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty-Three Dollars (\$6,678,223).
- 2.3 Construction Inspection (CI) Services. Subject to adjustments provided for in the Agreement, the not-to-exceed limit associated with this SA is Seventy-Nine Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy-Six Dollars (79,576). This Phase of CI Services is in addition to the previously authorized not-to-exceed limit of Five Million Three Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$5,386,859). The new total for CI services for Bridges A, B, and C and the Sanibel Toll Facility and Roadways is now Five Million Four Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Four Hundred and

- 2.4 Phase Schedule Extension Fees. In the event that this Phase Schedule is extended by agreement of Owner and CM due to changes in the Phase requested by Owner, CM shall be entitled to additional fee at the daily rate of Zero Dollars (\$0/day), without duplicating any portion of a fee increase as calculated in Section 3.02 of the Agreement for additional work which may have extended the Phase Schedule. [ref. Agreement Section 3.03]
- 2.5 Phase Contingency, Allowances & Contingency Reversion Schedule. The Phase GMP includes the specific amounts for CM Construction Contingency and Specified Allowances as set forth in Appendix 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein. [ref. Agreement Paragraph 4.03(3)] The contingency reversion schedule applicable for this Phase is also set forth in Appendix 2. [ref. Agreement Paragraph 4.03(4)]
- 2.6 Preconstruction Services. Subject to adjustments provided for in the Agreement, the not-to-exceed limit associated with this SA is Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (75,000). This Phase of Preconstruction Services is in addition to the previously authorized not-to-exceed limit of Eight Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred and Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$826,528). The new total for Preconstruction services for Bridges A, B, and C and the Sanibel Toll Facility and Roadways is now Nine Hundred One Thousand Five Hundred and Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$901,528) and is outside the Total GMP stated in Section 2.1 above. [ref. Agreement Paragraph 3.01(3)]

### CONTINGENCY REVERSION SCHEDULE

All unused CM Construction Contingency and/or Allowances at the end of this Phase (Sanibel Toll Facility and Roadways) shall revert to the overall GMP for all Phases.
