TASK INDEX

1.00 Construction Inspections Services

TASK 1.00 – CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES

During the construction phase, the CONSULTANT shall furnish professional services to ensure the integrity of the design intent as follows:

Task 1.01 Attend a pre-construction conference, provide assistance to County in conducting meeting, answering questions and provide necessary information.

Task 1.02 <u>CEI-Inspection and Testing</u>

Provide full-time inspection and on-site testing during construction. A senior construction inspector will be on site during all construction activities to monitor the contractor's progress and provide quality assurance testing of soil compaction, concrete placement, base compaction and asphalt compaction to assist the County in assuring that the construction is done in accordance with the plans and specifications. The senior construction inspector will notify the County Project Manager of any and all deficiencies and sub-standard work. The senior construction inspector will keep daily reports of all activities, equipment and manpower that is present on the job site and track quantities of materials incorporated into the project and stored on site for payment. The senior project inspector will assist the County Project Manager in reviewing the contractor's pay request and identify discrepancies in the quantities.

Task 1.03 Final inspection

Participate, in a pre-final inspection for the purpose of determining if the project is substantially complete, and participate in the preparation of a written "punch list" of all incomplete, defective or

Participate in a final inspection together with COUNTY and Contractor representatives to assure that all "punch list" list items are completed and the work is indeed completed in accordance with all contract documents.

PROJECT GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA for MISCELLANEOUS PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CN-03-07 CORKSCREW ROAD IMPROVEMENTS EAST OF BEN HILL GRIFFIN PKWY.

The COUNTY has established the following Guidelines, Criteria, Goals, Objectives, Constraints, Schedule, Budget and/or Requirements which shall serve as a guide to the CONSULTANT in performing the professional services and work to be provided pursuant to this Agreement.

The purpose of this document is to support the Project in sufficient detail that the CONSULTANT can follow the task descriptions and prepare the basis of compensation for services in sufficient detail to assure the COUNTY that all anticipated tasks necessary and the corresponding compensation required have been identified and defined by the CONSULTANT. The services provided by the CONSULTANT shall include observation of the Contractor's construction activities, preparation of samples for laboratory testing, field density testing of earthwork, road base and asphalt construction and witnessing of any tests required to certify new water or sewer mains. The Consultant's Senior Inspector will report directly to the COUNTY Project Manager, and will assist the COUNTY with any determination of sub-standard materials or construction efforts by the Contractor.

Should changes in design standards, unforeseen or unanticipated scope of services, environmental regulations, and permitting requirements occur after execution of this Professional Service Agreement which substantially affect the effort, or length of time required to complete this project, the compensation for additional effort will be negotiated. The fees shown on Exhibit B, and the number of Calendar days shown on Exhibit C, reflect continuous services by the CONSULTANT. If this contract requires a longer period of service by the CONSULTANT; the fees will be re-negotiated for the added duration.

All testing conducted by the CONSULTANT shall be in compliance with the Florida Department of Transportation, Manual of Florida Sampling and Testing Methods, ASTM standards or AASHTO guidelines.
