Lands Program, widely known as the Conservation 20/20 Program, to acquire and protect environmentally critical or sensitive land within Lee

County; and

Whereas: The Conservation 20/20 Program is a willing seller land acquisition

program that only considers the acquisition of environmentally critical or sensitive land from landowners who voluntarily submit an application to

the County; and

Whereas: The Gasparilla Island Conservation and Improvement Association

(GICIA) represents over 1,000 residents of Boca Grande and has actively promoted and encouraged land, water and wildlife conservation of the

Gasparilla Island area for nearly 34 years; and

Whereas: The GICIA owns and maintains more than one hundred acres of property

that will be forever protected from development and continues to

encourage and pursue the protection of other significant parcels; and

Whereas: The portion of Cayo Pelau Island located within Lee County was

nominated to the Conservation Lands (20/20) Program; and

Whereas: The GICIA Board of Directors voted to pledge \$10,000 towards the

purchase of Cayo Pelau Island in Lee County to emphasize their support of the Lee County Conservation 20/20 Program acquiring it as protection of

this property is critically important; and

Whereas: Lee County closed on the purchase of Cayo Pelau Island on February 1,


2007 with \$10,000 in GICIA contributory matching funds.
