

LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA
EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 24-10-
REPEALING AN EVACUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on October 6, 2024, declared a State of Local Emergency because of the serious health and safety threat to the lives and property of residents of Lee County, Florida from Hurricane Milton, Emergency Resolution No. 24-10-15; and

WHEREAS, Lee County Ordinance No. 87-01, states that when a quorum of the Board of County Commissioners is unable to meet, the Chairperson of the Board of County Commissioners, or the Vice-Chairperson in his/her absence, or the County Administrator or his/her designee in the absence of the Chairperson, or Vice-Chairperson is authorized to act in a State of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2024, Resolution No. 24-10-16 was issued ordering evacuation of certain areas of Lee County in anticipation of Hurricane Milton's landfall; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Milton and its effects no longer pose a serious threat or danger to the lives and property of the residents of Lee County, Florida.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution Number 24-10-16, declaring an Evacuation Order in Lee County, Florida during the Emergency resulting from Hurricane Milton, is hereby repealed effective immediately.
