Notice is hereby given that Lee County will apply for a USC Section 5339(c) – Low/No Emission Program grant with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) which will provide for capital project assistance to Lee County’s Transit Department, LeeTran.

Any interested party may request a public hearing by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners regarding the Program of Projects for this Urban Area Competitive Program grant application. To request a public hearing please submit a written request within ten (10) days of this notice to Lee County Transit 3401 Metro Parkway, Fort Myers, Florida 33901.

Project Description: The project cost of this USC Section 5339(c) Low/No Emission Program grant is estimated at \$3,863,430 for the federal share portion of FY 2022 appropriation available under the 5339(c) grant. Program funds will be matched with the state of Florida Department of Transportation’s (FDOT) Transportation Development Credit.

Proposed projects include funding for electric buses for LeeTran's fixed route bus service, the associated charging stations, related infrastructure expenses and workforce training.
