Lee County Library System update for Monday: Most libraries to reopen; Hurricane Milton impacts keep three closed

Fort Myers, FL, Oct. 13, 2024 – Lee County Library System operations will reopen for regular business beginning Monday, Oct. 14, although some locations remain unavailable due to storm-related impacts.

The Bonita Springs Public Library, Johann Fust Community Library (Boca Grande) and Captiva Memorial Library remain closed.

Services at Lee County Library locations include Wi-Fi, computer access, mobile printing and curbside holds pickup service. Patrons are encouraged to call to verify service availability. Due dates and hold pickup dates for physical materials have been extended.
