Lat &amp; long of each tower</li> <li>2. Proposed antenna height for each tower</li> <li>3. Proposed antenna directivity for each tower</li> <li>4. Proposed ERP for each LMR system at each tower</li> <li>5. Perform TDI at the countywide level</li> </ul>
Answer	The CONSULTANT will need to demonstrate that they have an understanding of propagation in so much that existing communications system coverage, integrity and quality are retained. The current plan is to install the facilities on County-owned land in Burnt Store, Lehigh Acres, North Fort Myers, as well as in unincorporated areas of Southwest and Southeast Fort Myers. Per Florida Statutes § 119.071(3)(c) the location of communication towers and other critical infrastructure that are used to support public safety are exempt from public record requirements. In most cases, the towers will be replacing existing leased structures; generally speaking, the existing towers are less than 300 feet. The COUNTY is currently soliciting proposals for the design phase for resilient communications tower infrastructure. The CONSULTANT will be expected to design tower infrastructure that maintains the existing coverage, integrity and quality of the communications system.
