## I. MOTION REQUESTED

A) Award Invitation to Bid No. B200027CJV, Electronic Waste Transportation, De-Manufacturing, and Recycling to Secure Recycling LLC for the transportation, de-manufacturing, and recycling of electronic waste derived from the County's E-waste collection program, on an as-needed basis, for an initial term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$66,000.00 for the initial three years.
B) Authorize the Chair to execute the contract documents on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners.
C) Grant the County Manager or designee the authority to renew the contract, for up to three additional one year periods, and to execute all associated documents, as approved in the departments' annual adopted budgets, if doing so is in the best interest of Lee County, and there are no cost increases associated with the renewal.

### II. ITEM SUMMARY

Awards a contract to Secured Recycling LLC to provide transportation, de-manufacturing, and recycling of electronic waste collected by Lee County after a competitive bid process. This contract is for \$66,000 (\$22,000/year) over a three year period, with three possible mutual 1-year extensions. This contract lowers our unit rates, with a projected \$3000/year cost reduction. Lee County has recycled E-Waste since 2001 as part of our fully integrated solid waste management system.

## III. BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

#### A) Board Action and Other History

Procurement Management obtained bids for the project known as Invitation to Bid No. B20027CJV, Electronic Waste Transportation, De-Manufacturing, and Recycling. On the bid deadline of January 21, 2020, Procurement Management received three submittals. After conducting an analysis of the bid submissions, Secured Recycling LLC was determined to be the responsible bidder with the lowest responsive bid.

Staff recommends awarding a contract to Secured Recycling LLC for use on an as-needed basis for an initial three-year period in the estimated amount of \$66,000.00 The contract can be renewed up to three additional one-year periods, upon the agreement of both parties. Total expenditures for these services provided in Fiscal Year 2019 were \$25,500.00, which is based on a higher rate than the awarding bid.
