

**MANAGEMENT STATUS REPORT FOR CONSERVATION 20/20 PRESERVES
(January – March 2023)**

GENERAL NOTE: Conservation 20/20 maintenance staff visit all primary use preserves daily to ensure the safety and cleanliness of public use amenities and restroom facilities and to empty the trash receptacles at these locations. The items listed in this report focus on management activities beyond these regular and recurring maintenance functions.

NOTE: Unless specifically stated all primary use, limited use, and water access preserves are open.
